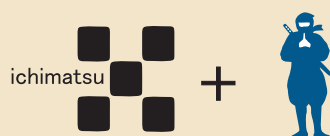
## Traditional Japanese patterns with a sense of fun

### Arrows and rabbits



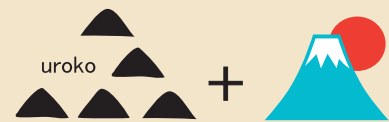
This pattern of straight arrows all pointing in the one direction are said to bring good fortune.

### Ichimatsu and Ninja



Ichimatsu is a geometric checkered design.

### Fish Scales and Mt.Fuji



This pattern represents fish scales, said to be helpful for greater purification.

### Blue sea waves and whales



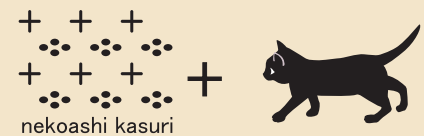
This geometric fan pattern represents waves on the blue sea. The calm waves express peacefulness.

### Shippou and squirrels



The eternal circles of the Shippou pattern represent good luck.

### Cat's paw prints and plus



This humorous design makes us think of a cat's paw print.

### Pots and the universe



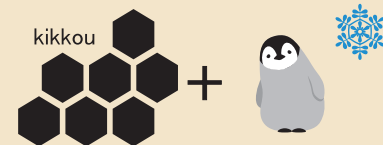
The simple classic pot design, often used for the Japanese tea-things.

### Plum flowers and bees



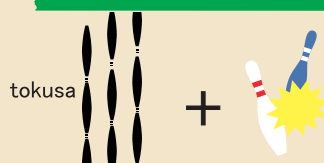
This geometric floral design of 5 circles represents the plum flower.

### Horsetails and bowling



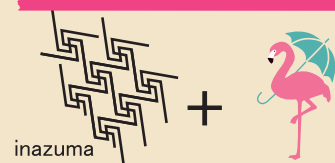
This pattern represents plants called horsetails. Those are growing in straight lines and said to bring good fortune.
